Now that fall is approaching we have moved into our new hours. We are open everyday from 7 am to 6 pm. Please let us know in advance if you need something outside of our hours and we will work to accommodate you. Please keep in mind we offer winterization, detailing and boat wrapping. We are here to help with all of your boating services.

As many of you know Island Harbor Marina docks received a great deal of damage from Hurricane Irene. We are in the process of calling slips owners to discuss individual contracts and reimbursements. Below are the latest details regarding the marina:

**BOTH BOAT RAMPS ARE OPERATIONAL:** Please remember that Island Harbor Marina facility customers always receive priority, especially when limited parking conditions exist.

**GAS DOCK:** Island Harbor Marina staff is able to assist you with pumping gas. We have a temporary floating dock for fueling.

**STORAGE CUSTOMERS:** Valet services have resumed operation as usual. The new fence was installed on the 13<sup>th</sup> of September and all storage customers should resume normal services.

**FLOATING SLIP CUSTOMERS:** We will be able to accommodate floating slip customers in our storage area if you wish to transfer. Larger vessels/deep draft vessels, please check with IHM Dock Master. We may need to refund slip rentals until we can get new sizable, deep draft, slips in place.

We do have some GOOD news for you, in that we are planning to build new docks in a 3 to 6 month time frame! Please check in with IHM website for updates. We truly appreciate your patience in this time of recovery.
